# Project Proposals

---

- You should have today:

# Project Proposals

---

- Description of what system will do
  - Similar to description on web site
- Project timetable
  - Status at major checkpoints (course sched)
  - Intermediate milestones
  - Parallel subprojects (e.g. broken down by team member)
- Estimate of how much effort
  - This will be wildly inaccurate

# Project Proposals, contd.

---

- How will you know it works?
  - How do you propose to test it?
  - How do you propose to demonstrate it?
  - What will you throw at it?
